BACKGROUND: On November 3, 2009 (Item 3.50), the Board awarded a contract for the construction of street improvements for Phase 1 of the Mecca Streets Revitalization Project. That construction has been completed.

On August 31, 2010 (Item 3.78), the Board awarded a contract for the construction of street improvements for Phase 2 of the Mecca Streets Revitalization Project. That construction is in progress.

As a continuation of the street improvements in downtown Mecca, staff recommends that the Board advertise Phase 3 of the Mecca Streets Revitalization Project for the construction of street improvements on the following streets.

ROAD:	FROM:	TO:
66 th Avenue	West of Date Palm Street	Home Avenue
Dale Kiler Road	South of 66 th Avenue	2 nd Street
Home Avenue	66 th Avenue	2 nd Street

The improvements are intended to benefit the community by eliminating blight and by providing streets that will improve vehicular travel, pedestrian access and street drainage. The improvements will include the reconstruction of the existing pavement and the addition of sidewalk, curb, gutter and the replacement street lighting.

Construction of the Phase 3 street improvements will begin as soon as the Redevelopment Agency completes the construction of an 18" waterline in 66th Avenue. The completion of the street improvements is intended to coincide with the opening of the Mecca Boys and Girls Club.

The proposed work for the Phase 3 streets will be funded by the Redevelopment Agency under the terms and established budget of a cooperative agreement that will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution prior to, or concurrent with, the award of the construction contract.

Subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors, additional future phases of construction are anticipated to bring street improvements to: 66th Avenue, 4th Street, 6th Street, 7th Street, Hammond Road, Lincoln Street, Coahuilla Street, Date Palm Street, Brown Street, Dale Kiler Road, Home Avenue and Frank J. Valdovino Road.

There will be no construction cost incurred until FY 2011/12

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.
