3. Receive and file the presentation of the May 18, 2011 Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC election results.

BACKGROUND:

On April 26, 2011, pursuant to Minute Order 4.3, the Board of Directors approved the use of the Lakeland Village/Wildomar Project Area Committee (PAC) Election and Formation Procedures (Procedures) that were adopted on December 15, 2009, with clarifications, for the May 18, 2011 Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC election.

Pursuant to Section 12.1 of the procedures, Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (RDA) staff held two pre-election informational meetings at the Mission Trail Library located in Wildomar, California. The first meeting was held on March 16, 2011 and the second meeting was held on April 6, 2011. At each meeting, the current PAC members and the rest of Lakeland Village/Wildomar community in attendance were advised the election meeting would be held on May 18, 2011 and the application deadline would be April 18, 2011.

In addition to the pre-election meetings held, a public notice was published in the Press Enterprise on March 1, 15, 22, 29, April 5, and April 15; and posted on the agency's website (per Section 11.2 of the Procedures). In addition, notices were posted throughout the Lakeland Village and Wildomar communities about the pre-election informational meetings, application deadline, and election meeting.

By the April 18, 2011 deadline, a total of seven applications were submitted to the RDA, either in person or by U.S. mail (as indicated in Section 14.2 of the Procedures). RDA staff assessed the validity of each application and verified all documentation submitted by each candidate as proof of eligibility in order to ensure that each applicant met the requirements pursuant to Section 13.0 of the Procedures. All seven applications were deemed complete and valid.

On May 18, 2011, the RDA conducted the election meeting at the Mission Trail Library pursuant to Section 15.0 of the Procedures. A total of seven candidates ran for election: five candidates in the category of Residential Owner-Occupant and two in the category of Community Organization. The five candidates in the category of Residential Owner-Occupant were elected pursuant to Section 15.5.2 of the Procedures, and the two candidates in the category of Community Organization were appointed pursuant to Section 11.3 of the Procedures. The May 18, 2011 Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC Election Tally Sheet is included as Attachment A for reference. A total of seven seats in the PAC were filled, leaving a total of ten vacancies. The 2011-2014 Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC Member Roster and Composition is presented to the Board as Attachment B.

Furthermore, the frequency of the PAC meetings has changed from monthly to bi-monthly. As a result, additional clarifications to the procedures are required in order to reflect such change in the frequency. Therefore, the 2011-2014 PAC will convene on July 20, 2011.

On April 26, 2011, pursuant to Minute Order 4.3, the Board directed RDA staff to coordinate with the PAC members elected on May 18, 2011 to amend the Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC Election and Formation Procedures and collectively agree on any amendments to such procedures, in preparation for Board approval. These efforts will begin after the July 20, 2011 PAC meeting.

RDA staff recommends that the Board adopt the finding, pursuant to paragraph 2 of subsection "d" of Section 33385 of the California Redevelopment Law ("CRL"), that all Lakeland Village/Wildomar Project Area Committee (PAC) Formation and Election Procedures were followed for the election that took place on May 18, 2011; deem the May 18, 2011 election valid; and receive and file the presentation of the Lakeland Village/Wildomar PAC election results.
