BACKGROUND:

In 1938, the Santa Ana River broke free from its banks and flooded thousands of acres. As a result of this catastrophe, the construction of the Prado Dam was initiated. Completed in 1941, the Prado Dam increased protection from devastating floods to property downstream. In 1964, the Santa Ana River Mainstem Project (SARM) was proposed and construction began in 1989.

The SARM Project is designed to provide flood protection for residences and businesses in the Southern California communities of Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties. The proposed improvements to the system cover 75 miles, from the headwater of Santa Ana River east of the city of San Bernardino to the mouth of the river at the Pacific Ocean between the cities of Newport Beach and Huntington Beach.

The Reach 9, Phase 2A Embankment Project is one of the portions of the SARM project. This portion of the project is necessary to protect the lives and properties of individuals residing in the Green River Housing Estates, and the 91 Freeway. This project would provide approximately 4,500 feet of bank stabilization.

Negotiations have been conducted with the affected owners, but to date, have not been successful. Although these negotiations will continue in order to facilitate the timely construction of the flood control facilities for the Santa Ana Mainstem Project, staff is recommending the approval of Resolution No. F2011-09.

RESOLUTION NO. F2011-09

RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY REGARDING THE SANTA ANA RIVER MAINSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS, the portions of real properties (and the real property) that are the subjects of this Resolution (collectively the "Subject Properties") are located in the city of Corona, County of Riverside, California; are located in the general vicinity of Green River Road and State Highways 71 and 91; are legally described and visually depicted in the documents attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B"; and are referred to in attached Exhibits "A" and "B" as Parcel 2105-1A (which is a portion of Riverside County Assessor's Parcel No. ("APN") 101-130-077), Parcel 2105-1B (which is the entirety of Riverside County APN 101-130-076), Parcel 2105-2 (which is a portion of Riverside County APN 101-130-085), Parcels 2105-3A and 2105-3B and 2105-3C (which are each portions of Riverside County APN 101-241-038), Parcels 2105-5A and 2105-5B (which are each portions of Riverside County APN 101-260-051), Parcels 2105-6A and 2105-6B (which are each portions of Riverside County APN 101-250-065), Parcel 2105-8 (which comprises the entire geographical surface area of Riverside County APN 101-140-004), and Parcels 2105-10 and 2105-10T1 and 2105-10T2 (which are each portions of the State of California's right-of-way for State Highway 91);

WHEREAS, the proposed project that is the subject of this Resolution (the "Proposed Project") is one to develop and construct a public flood control levee, and is one for other uses incidental to that stated use and required by that stated use (including but not limited to the development and construction of an access road, and including but not limited to the incidental creation of "remnant[s]" within the meaning of Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.410);

WHEREAS, the interests in property that are the subjects of this Resolution (collectively the "Subject Property Interests") are: (a) fee simple ownerships in Parcels 2105-1A, 2105-1B, 2105-2, 2105-3A, 2105-5A and 2105-6A; (b) perpetual subsurface easements in Parcels 2105-

3B, 2105-3C, 2105-5B and 2105-6B; (c) perpetual surface easements in Parcels 2105-8 and 2105-10; and (d) temporary construction easements in Parcels 2105-10T1 and 2105-10T2.

WHEREAS, the authorities that authorize the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (the "District") to acquire the Subject Property Interests by eminent domain include Article 1, Section 19 of the California Constitution; Section 25350.5 of the Government Code; Section 48-9 of the Water Code-Appendix; and Sections 1240.010, 1240.020, 1240.030, 1240.040, 1240.110, 1240.410, 1240.510 and 1240.610 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, not less than four-fifths of all members concurring, in regular session assembled on June 14, 2011, that this Board finds and determines each of the following:

- 1. Notice of the Board's intention to adopt this Resolution of Necessity was duly given as required by Section 1245.235 of the Code of Civil Procedure and, on the date and at the time and place fixed for hearing, this Board did hear and consider all of the evidence presented;
 - 2. The public interest and necessity require the Proposed Project;
- 3. The Proposed Project is planned and located in the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury;
 - 4. The Subject Property Interests are necessary for the Proposed Project;
- 5. The offers required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code have been made to the owner(s) of record of the Subject Properties; and
- 6. To the extent that the Subject Properties are already devoted to public uses, the use of the Proposed Project is a compatible use that will not unreasonably interfere with, or impair the continuance of the public uses as they presently exist or may reasonably be expected to exist in the future (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.510) or the use of the

Proposed Project is a more necessary public use than are the presently existing public uses (California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.610).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the County Counsel of the County of Riverside (and any associated private attorneys) are hereby authorized and empowered:

- 1. To acquire (in the name of the District) the Subject Property Interests by condemnation in accordance with the Constitution and laws relating to eminent domain.
- 2. To prepare and prosecute in the name of the District such proceedings in the proper court having jurisdiction thereof as are necessary for such acquisition.
- 3. To apply to the court for orders to deposit the probable amount of compensation out of proper funds under the control of the District into the County Treasury and to move for orders permitting the District to take prejudgment possession and use the Subject Property Interests.
- 4. To compromise and settle such proceedings if such settlement can be reached and. in that event, to take all necessary actions to complete the acquisitions, including stipulations as to judgment and other matters, and the causing of all payments to be made.




