SUBJECT: FIRST DISTRICT USE OF COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DESIGNATION FUNDS (CIDF): Memorial Honor Detail-Riverside National Cemetery

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the Memorial Honor Detail-Riverside National Cemetery;
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

Increase Appropriations:

Decrease Board Designation:

BACKGROUND: The Memorial Honor Detail is a group of 350 volunteers, including 25 teams, 7 dispatchers, 2 qualified armorers and a 12 member Board of Directors. These concerned citizens give freely of their time to ensure that their fallen comrades get the honor they deserve. As of December 31, 2010 the Memorial Honor Detail has provided military honors for over 30,000 deceased veterans at the Riverside National Cemetery who otherwise would not have been buried with military honors.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$5,000 to support the Memorial Honor Detail-Riverside National Cemetery.
