FIND serves as a food distribution center for multiple non-profit organizations. I would like to contribute \$30,000 for a marketing plan to increase their donor base and the remaining \$50,000 to be used towards operational costs.

BIENESTAR will target high risk and hard-to-reach individuals of all racial/ethnic minority communities in the eastern Coachella Valley.

Coachella Valley Rescue Mission provides shelter, food, counseling services and other services to individuals and families who are in need of assistance.
