Dear Chief Hawkins:

The Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency (RCHCA) is of the understanding that Riverside County Fire has two Vermeer chippers that they are considering making available as surplus equipment.

The RCHCA oversees the management of reserve lands set aside for the protection of the Stephens' kangaroo rat (SKR). The purchase of costly equipment like chippers is out of the question for reserves with limited funding. Lake Mathews-Estelle Mountain Reserve and Southwestern Riverside County Multi-Species Reserve are both reserves that have managers and are actively managing the land for SKR. Each of these reserves would benefit greatly from having a chipper on site.

The following information identifies the chippers that you are considering making available as surplus equipment:
