BACKGROUND:

On June 22, 2010 (#3.5), the Board approved the Community Services Block Grant Discretionary Agreement #10F-4109 to fund the Food Security Project for the term June 30, 2010 through June 30, 2011 in the amount of \$100,000.

Community Action Partnership of Riverside County (CAP Riverside) developed a Food Security Project to serve 1,000 low-income households throughout Riverside County. The project will help to modify unhealthy behaviors by leveraging CAP Riverside's food support resources with community partners who provide healthy living activities/education and/or food. These resources help to support low-income households as they change their behaviors. Community resources, budgeting, financial management, healthy living information, and referrals to food support programs all establish a foundation for healthy, nutritious, active, and financially sound green living for poor households.

Amendment #1 modifies provisions relating to preparing and submitting the Close-Out Report.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required.
