

BACKGROUND: On May 18, 2011, the Mayor of Norco approved the Third Amendment to the city's law enforcement services Agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department to the city of Norco with the deletion of 2 Deputy Sheriff-Traffic Officer positions. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

This personnel action will result in the deletion of the following Position Control Numbers for the Deputy Sheriff positions: 3642 and 3885.

Based on the July 1, 2011 date for the service reduction, staff estimates a decrease in Contract City law enforcement revenue of \$458,000.

- Two (2) Community Service Officer positions
