BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements including construction of curb, asphalt concrete dike, signing and striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, roadside signs and associated work as may be required. The proposed traffic signal will help prevent eastbound motorists from queuing over the railroad track when the traffic light is red at Buchanan Street.


This is an interim safety improvement to address the queuing problem until the Magnolia Avenue railroad grade separation project is in place. The anticipated date to begin construction for grade separation project is late 2013.

Annual operation and maintenance costs for this traffic signal are estimated at \$2,500 to be funded from gas tax.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
