BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541(RCC Chapter 8.120), 348 (RCC Title 17) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors issued an Order to Abate in this case on Jan. 11, 2011 and recorded on Jan. 19, 2011, as document number 2077-0027294. Subsequently, the property was brought into compliance.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Abatement Costs has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
