- 3) Direct county assistance in the initial marketing and startup of RCMEA as needed
- 4) Direct EDA to provide financial assistance in the establishment of RCMEA as a not for profit
- 5) Direct EDA and or other county departments to work in support of regulatory and tax reforms that will create and maintain jobs in our manufacturing industry

BACKGROUND: Riverside County is home to an estimated 4000 manufacturing firms which create thousands of direct jobs for our workforce. In addition to the direct jobs created by these manufacturers, thousands of jobs are also created in the supply chain and distribution network. This industry pays millions each year in local sales and property taxes and seeks little assistance from county, city, state, or federal government. Encouraging and assisting in establishing this important association demonstrates that the county supports small business and manufacturers who export products around the globe.
