## **BACKGROUND** (Continued)

The Riverside County Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program (RivCoVEAP) will serve 90 veterans countywide. The program will use sector employment strategies using industry-specific training to prepare veterans for skilled positions in high-wage, high-growth occupations in renewable energy and healthcare. The RivCoVEAP will target recently separated veterans, service-connected disabled veterans, and campaign veterans.

16 key partners have come together in support of this project. Through this program, veterans will have access to a workforce initiative that recognizes the skills and life experiences they have gained from military service. The duration of the program will cover 22 months beginning May 1, 2011 through March 31, 2013.
