BACKGROUND:

The proposed Mission Trails Library Community Room Expansion has been identified as a priority project necessary to serve the greater Elsinore area. Pursuant to Ordinance 659.6, the DIF fee program allows for the use of DIF funds for facilities within specific areas identified on the Public Facilities List through the year 2010.
