BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of sidewalks on Camino Campanero and on 66th Avenue. This project will provide new segments of sidewalk on Camino Campanero in the Desert Hot Springs area and on 66th Avenue in the Mecca area. The sidewalk on Camino Campanero is on the south side and begins at Avenida Descanso and ends at Avenida Florencita, over 2100' of 6' wide sidewalk. The sidewalk on 66th Ave is on the south side and begins at Tyler Street and ends at Martinez Road, providing over 2900' of mainly 6' wide sidewalk.

At both locations, the children walk to school on the dusty graded shoulder. When it rains, the children tend to walk in the street very close to the traffic. The proposed sidewalk will provide a safe all-weather path of travel to school for children and other pedestrians. Additional safety improvements include the installation of access ramps at the intersections and new street name signs on Camino Campanero.

The projects are partially funded with SB 821 Grant funds from RCTC for which the County successfully competed. The SB821 program is a major source of funding of sidewalk projects.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.




