BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 (RCC Chapter 17) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Notices of Violation and Administrative Citations were issued. Subsequently, on or about Jan. 6, 2010, the property was brought into compliance.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Abatement Costs has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law.
