BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15), and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Notices of Violation were issued. Subsequently, on or about Dec. 23, 2003, the property owners brought the subject property into compliance.

There are other cases for which the costs sought at this Statement of Abatement Costs hearing do not pertain (CV07-3542 & CV07-4249). For these cases, the County of Riverside Code Enforcement Department has not yet calculated the costs.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Abatement Costs has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
