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BACKGROUND:

On September 28, 2010, the Board of Supervisors approved the plans and specifications and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids for the Crestmore Manor HVAC Replacement Project. On November 10, 2010, twelve contractors attended a mandatory job walk.

On November 29, 2010 the bids were opened and Pardess Air Incorporated was determined to be the lowest responsive bidder.

The Economic Development Agency (EDA) has evaluated the bids and has found the bids to be economically unviable. EDA is therefore requesting the Board of Supervisors reject all bids and authorize the Clerk of the Board to re-advertise for bids using a reduced scope of the plans and specifications originally approved by the Board of Supervisors.
