

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Boston University Medical Campus is the prime recipient and RCRMC is the sub grantee that will administer the project. RCRMC will be participating in a study of attitudes and factors affecting infant care.

A recruiter, designated by RCRMC, will identify newly delivered mothers who meet the study criteria. The recruiter will approach the mothers and seek their consent to participate in the study. All data collected will be sent to the Boston University staff researchers.
