BACKGROUND:

The Economic Development Agency (EDA) is proposing an increase to certain parking fees be adopted for FY 2011/2012 to recover costs associated with operating parking facilities, including maintenance. Some costs associated with maintenance include gate and elevator repairs, signage and striping of parking stalls. The proposed rate submittal is in accordance with Board Policy B-4, which requires submittal of cost recovery rates to the Board of Supervisors on an annual basis. EDA will develop an alternative rate methodology for FY 2012/13 that will include recommendations made by the Auditor-Controller and with the continued assistance of the Executive Office.

Ordinance No. 626.8 amends Ordinance No. 626 to change the parking agency from the Director of the Department of Facilities Management to the Assistant County Executive Officer of the Economic Development Agency; increase parking fines from \$40.00 to \$53.00; add other additional penalties and assessments related to Disabled Persons parking; eliminate vendor and temporary parking permits; and incorporates other minor changes. Monthly parking rates remain unchanged, except for the addition of motorcycle parking at a rate of \$7.00 per month. Several other miscellaneous parking rates are also increased. The new rates would go into effect 60 days after its adoption.

The attached charts highlight changes to monthly and non-monthly parking.

ORDINANCE NO. 626.8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 626

RELATING TO

COUNTY PARKING FACILITIES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

- Section 5, subsections e. and f. of Ordinance No. 626 are deleted in their entirety.
- Section 2. Section 5, subsections g. and h. of Ordinance No. 626 are relettered as subsections e. and f. respectively.
- Section 3. Section 5, former subsection g. of Ordinance No. 626 is amended to read as follows:
 - "e. Parking Validation Stamp A person in possession of a stamp(s) may park his vehicle in a County parking structure for the total time of the validation without paying the usually required fee."
- Section 4. Section 5, subsections a., b., and c. of Ordinance No. 626 are amended to read as follows:
 - "a. Blue Triangle Permit, Blue Diamond Permit or Blue Square Permit A vehicle properly displaying this permit may be parked in the employee-only areas of all County parking facilities provided any applicable fee has been paid.
 - b. White Triangle Permit, Red Diamond Permit or Blue and Yellow Square Permit A vehicle properly displaying this permit may be parked in the employee-only or the public-only areas of all County parking facilities provided any applicable fee has been paid.
 - c. Parking Placard Permit A vehicle properly displaying this permit may be parked in the employee-only or the public-only areas of all County parking facilities provided any applicable fee has been paid."

Section 8 of Ordinance No. 626 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. RESERVED PARKING SPACES.

The Assistant County Executive Officer of the Economic Development Agency, or his or her designee, shall direct and control the designation of reserved parking spaces. Pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22511.7, he or she may reserve parking spaces for the exclusive use of any disabled person or disabled veteran displaying a special license plate or placard issued in accordance with Vehicle Code Section 22511.5. The Assistant or designee may also reserve parking spaces for the exclusive use of County officials, agencies, departments or employees."

Section 7. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 626 is amended to read as follows:

"No County employee, on or off duty, shall park a vehicle in public-only areas of any County parking facility, unless the vehicle properly displays a White Triangle Permit, a Red Diamond Permit, a Blue and Yellow Square Permit or a Parking Placard Permit. No County employee or any other person shall do any of the following:

- a. Park in a designated handicapped space, without displaying a special license plate or placard issued in accordance with Vehicle Code Section 22511.5.
 - b. Park in an area not designated for parking.
 - c. Park in a designated red zone.
 - d. Park in a reserved space without the appropriate authorization.
- e. Park a County vehicle in a public-only parking area, without displaying a White Triangle Permit, a Red Diamond Permit, a Blue and Yellow Square Permit or a Parking Placard Permit.
 - f. Park outside the confines of a parking space.
 - g. Occupy more than one parking space.
 - h. Block or obstruct a driveway, toll booth, or another vehicle.
 - i. Fail to display a required parking permit.
 - j. Fail to pay a required monthly parking fee.

k.	Fail	to	pay	a	req	prired	exit	fee.

- Facilitate a person's failure to pay a required exit fee by allowing him to use a parking access device that he was not issued.
 - m. Violate a parking time limit."
- Section 8. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 626 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 11. ENFORCEMENT.

This ordinance shall be enforced by a County Parking Representative or Ordinance

Enforcement Officer, under the direction and control of the Assistant County Executive

Officer of the Economic Development Agency or his or her designee."

Section 9. The first paragraph of Section 12 of Ordinance No. 626 is amended to read as follows:

"Any person violating Section 9.a. of this ordinance shall be punished by a three hundred and sixty dollar (\$360.00) fine and may have his parking permit and parking access device revoked. If a Section 9.a. citation is cancelled because the person receiving the citation shows proof that he was issued a valid license plate or placard, a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) cancellation fee may be charged pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 40226. Any person who violates any other provision of Section 9. of this ordinance shall be issued a fifty-three dollar (\$53.00) fine and may have his parking permit and parking access device revoked. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) fee may be added to any fine each time a check is returned for insufficient funds and an administrative charge may be added to any delinquent fine to cover the costs of collection."

- Section 10. Section 12 of Ordinance No. 626 shall have the following a. and b. inserted between the first and second paragraphs:
- "a. A \$100 additional penalty may be added to all violations relating to Disabled

 Persons or Disabled Veterans (DP) spaces and placards; the collected additional penalties shall be
 set aside and used for improving enforcement of DP parking spaces and placards;

b. A 20% assessment may be added to all violations (on-street or off-street)
 pertaining to DP spaces (including ramps and access); the collected assessments shall be used by
 the County for services to elderly or functionally impaired adults pursuant to Penal Code 1465.5."
 Section 11. Section 14 of Ordinance No. 626 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"Section 14. PARKING FEES. Parking fees related to the parking of vehicles in County parking facilities are hereby established as follows:
