BACKGROUND (Continued):

On December 30, 2010 the department of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) accepted the request for change of ownership for Blythe Ambulance Services, Inc. to American Medical Response dba Springs Ambulance Service, Inc.

Effective January 1, 2011, (AMR) will be serving the remainder of the contract doing business as Blythe Ambulance Services, Inc. All other provisions in the agreement will stay the same.

CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF AGREEMENT

WITH

COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

AND

**SPRINGS AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC.
FORMERLY KNOWN AS BLYTHE AMBULANCE SERVICES, INC.**

This Consent to Assignment is entered into as of the effective date set forth below by County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY"), and Blythe Ambulance Services, Inc. (herein after referred to as "CONTRACTOR").

RECITALS

- A.** On April 25, 2002 the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into an agreement for Ambulance Services, identified as contract #DPH02K.097 (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement".)
- B.** Article 9, Entire Agreement, of the Agreement states that the services may not be changed without the prior written consent of COUNTY. A change in the business structure or majority ownership of CONTRACTOR is change or modify for purposes of this Agreement.
- C.** Blythe Ambulance Services, Inc. now desires to obtain COUNTY'S consent to assign said Agreement due to name change of CONTRACTOR to Springs Ambulance Service, Inc..

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, COUNTY agrees as follows:

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

1. CONSENT.

COUNTY consents to the assignment by CONTRACTOR of Agreement, as represented by

2. TERMS.

All terms of the Agreement, inclusive of obligations and liabilities, shall be and remain fully applicable to CONTRACTOR and the services to be performed there under as when first executed. All references in said Agreement to CONTRACTOR shall hereafter be understood to refer to Springs Ambulance Service, Inc.,

3. NOTICES
