BACKGROUND (Continued): Cal EMA awarded Riverside OA \$193,030 in BZPP funding January of 2009 and Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved the request to accept the funding on March 3, 2009, Agenda # 3.14. CalEMA contacted Riverside County OA to offer additional funding for the City of Riverside Police Department in May of 2011. Riverside County OA along with Riverside Police Department completed the paperwork for this funding and submitted it to CalEMA. On September 19, 2011 Riverside County Operational Area received notification of spending approval for the additional amount of \$193,030 from CalEMA. \$187,240 of this additional funding will be passed through to Riverside Police Department to purchase equipment and \$5,790 will be retained by Riverside County Fire Department for local administrative fees.
