BACKGROUND: The Santa Margarita River Watershed Clean-Up, founded in 1995, is an annual event receiving volunteer support from United States Forest Service, Riverside County Code Enforcement, Riverside County Flood Control, Riverside County Park and Open Space, Department of Fish and Game, the Santa Rosa Plateau Ecological Reserve and The Nature Conservancy. The Santa Margarita River Watershed Clean Up helps restore water quality along the Santa Margarita River and its tributaries affected by illegal dumping in the neighboring canyons and creeks primarily in unincorporated Riverside County and adjacent designated open space.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$500 to support the efforts of The Nature Conservancy.
