

- 2. Appoint the Director of the Riverside County Department of Mental Health as the authorized official to legally and financially bind the County to execute future Medicare applications and related agreements.

BACKGROUND:

Departmental Concurrence

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The Riverside County Department of Mental Health (RCDMH) is currently in the process of completing its Medicare Program Enrollment Application as required by the Centers for Medicare (Continued on Page 2)

BACKGROUND (CONTINUED):

and Medicaid Services (CMS). The Medicare application process requires the County to agree to accept certain financial obligations in order to enroll in the Medicare Program. Moreover, as part of the application process, federal administrators will require additional agreements by the the County in order to renew or supplement the Medicare application. The Director of Mental Health does not currently have the appropriate authorization to execute such Medicare applications. The Director of Mental Health, as provided in Policy A-30, seeks the Board's authority to execute the current Medicare Program Enrollment Applications as well as all future applications and necessary agreements needed to effectuate such applications.

The current CMS Medicare Enrollment Application highlights in Section 5 titled "Ownership Interest and/or Managing Control Information of Organizations that "any Medicare application letter must be signed by an "authorized official" of the government agency who has the authority to legally and financially bind the government to the laws, regulations, and program instructions of Medicare. Therefore, the RCDMH is requesting that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Medicare application letter on behalf of the RCDMH for the completion of its Medicare application. In the future, the Director of Mental Health will constitute the authorized official to execute these applications.

PERFORMANCE PERIOD:

This Medicare application will be in effect for FY 11/12 and will continue until CMS requires the RCDMH to update and/or renew its Medicare application.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding would be in the form of Medicare/Medicaid funds, and no County funds are required.
