BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated August 16, 2011 (agenda item 3.94), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of pedestrian sidewalk and associated improvements on Camino Campanero in the Desert Hot Springs area and on 66th Avenue in the Mecca area. Additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by the Board by this agenda item.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, September 7, 2011. Six bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Desert Concepts Construction, Inc. of Palm Desert in the amount of \$478,435 which is \$61,565 (11.4%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

This project will provide new segments of sidewalk on Camino Campanero in the Desert Hot Springs area and on 66th Avenue in the Mecca area. The sidewalk on Camino Campanero is on the south side and begins at Avenida Descanso and ends at Avenida Florencita, over 2100' of 6' wide sidewalk. The sidewalk on 66th Ave is on the south side and begins at Tyler Street and ends at Martinez Road, providing over 2900' of mainly 6' wide sidewalk.

At both locations, the children walk to school on the dusty graded shoulder. When it rains, the children tend to walk in the street very close to the traffic. The proposed sidewalk will provide a safe all-weather path of travel to school for children and other pedestrians. Additional safety improvements include the installation of access ramps at the intersections and new street name signs on Camino Campanero.

The projects are partially funded with SB 821 grant funds from RCTC for which the County successfully competed. The SB 821 program is a major source of funding of sidewalk projects.

The Contractor has executed the contract and has provided performance and payment bonds.

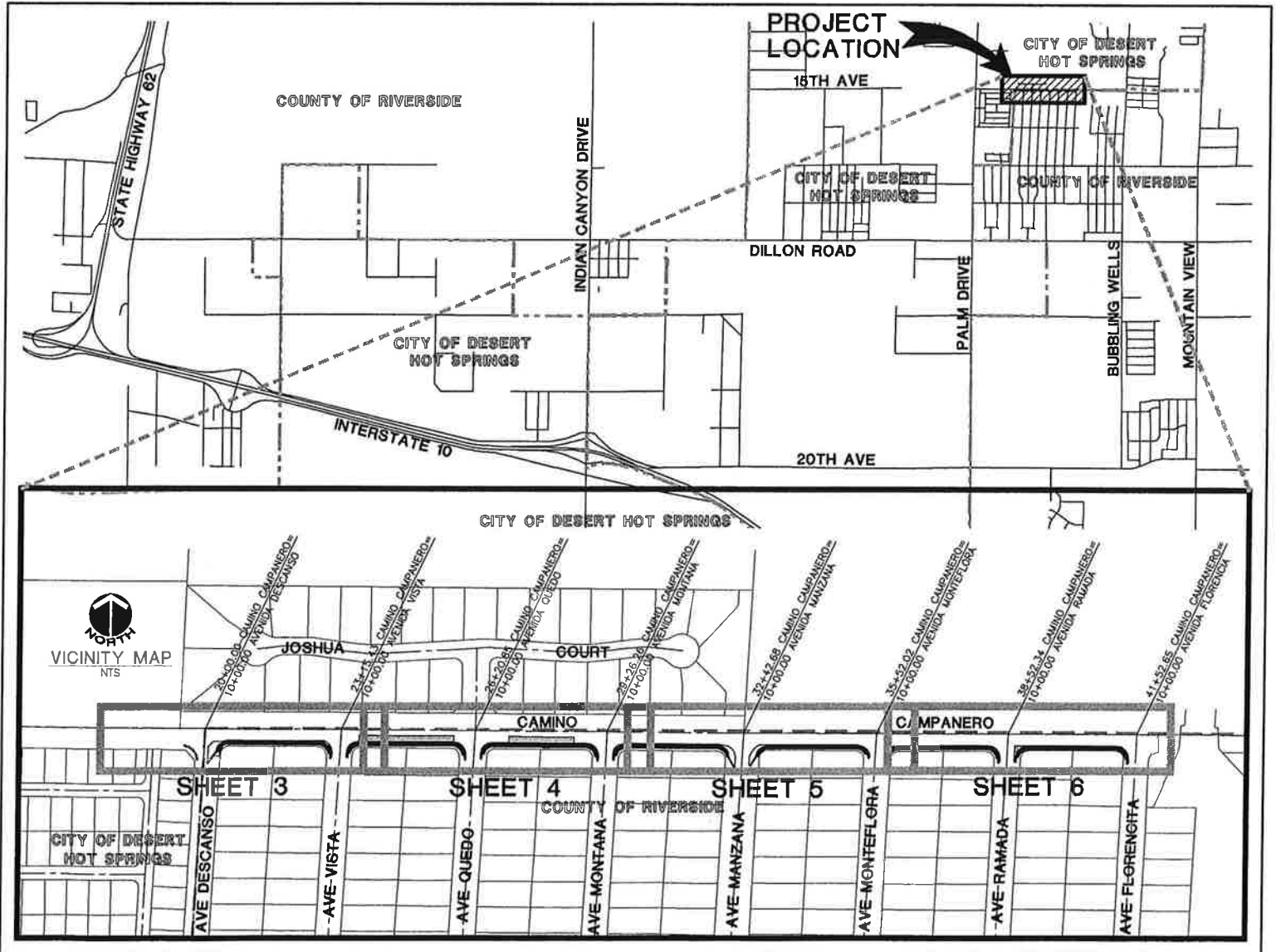

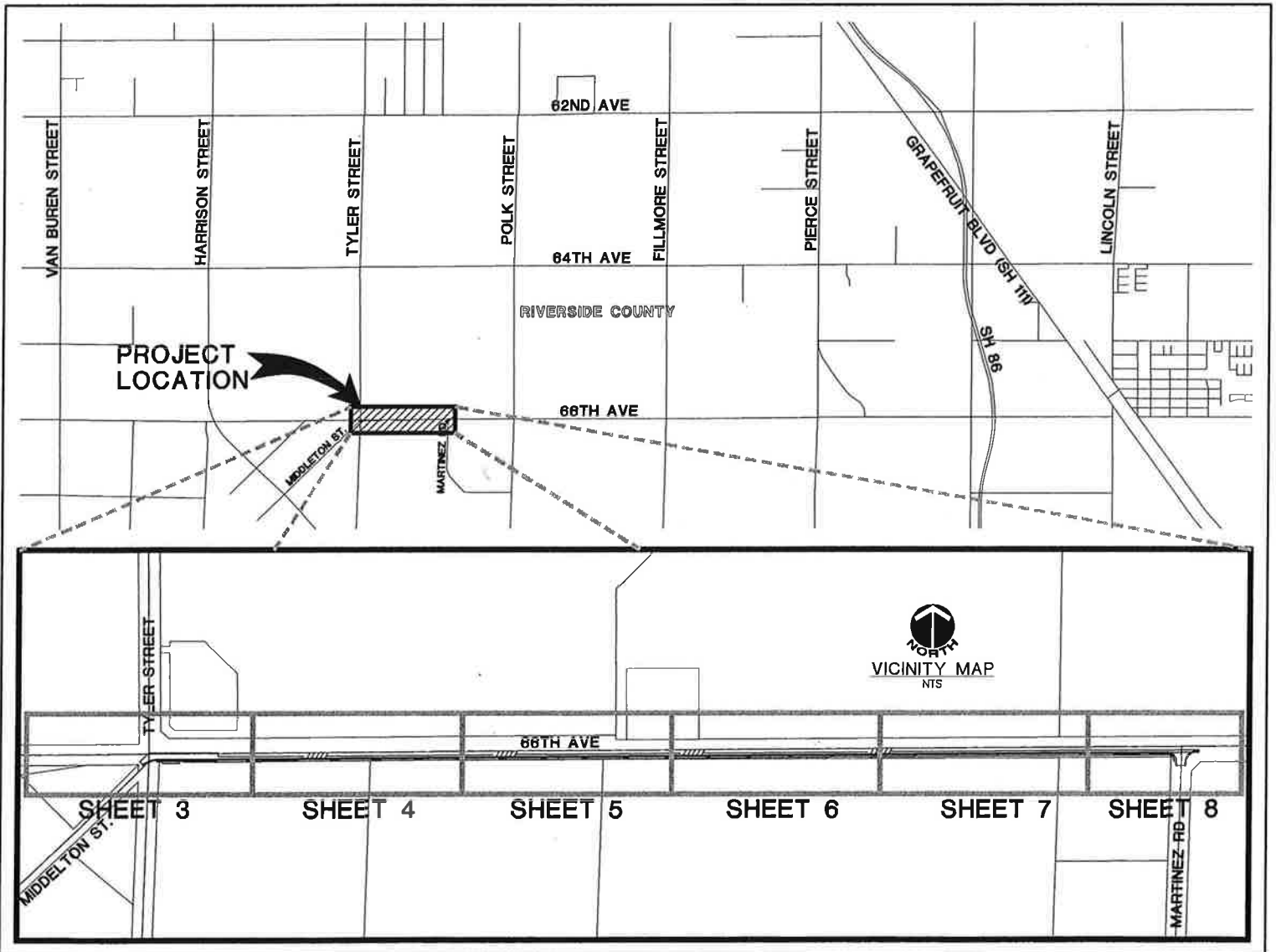

W I T N E S S E T H

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Coachella Valley Sidewalk Projects, Camino Campanero and 66th Avenue, Project Nos. C1-0433 and C1-0434**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

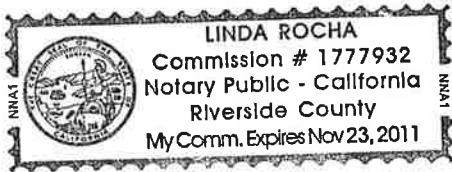

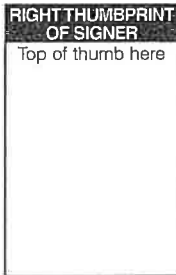

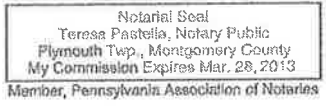
