3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE RELATING
4 TO THE REIMBURSEMENT OF INCARCERATION COSTS AND
5 INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.1c
6

7 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

8 Section 1. FINDINGS. The Board of Supervisors finds that the costs to incarcerate
9 persons in County Jail facilities continually increase and, as a consequence, require a significant
10 expenditure from the County's general fund.

11 Section 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to incorporate the provisions
12 of California Penal Code Section 1203.1c, which allows the courts in Riverside County to order, as a
13 condition of probation, that each probationer pay the County the reasonable cost of incarceration in a
14 Riverside County jail, including incarceration pending disposition of the case.

15 Section 3. PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.1c ADOPTED BY REFERENCE.
16 California Penal Code Section 1203.1c and any subsequent amendments to said section are hereby
17 adopted by the County, and incorporated by reference herein.

18 Section 4. COLLECTION OF MONEYS. The Chief Probation Officer of the
19 Riverside County is hereby designated as the County Officer responsible for collection of moneys ordered
20 to be paid pursuant to Penal Code Section 1203.1c. Pursuant to subdivision (b) of Penal Code Section
21 1203.1d, , incarceration costs imposed by this Ordinance shall be Priority 4 reimbursable costs to be
22 disbursed after restitution ordered to or on behalf of, the victim pursuant to subdivision (f) of Section
23 1202.4 (Priority 1), state surcharge ordered pursuant to Section 1465.7 (Priority 2) and fines, penalty
24 assessments, and restitution fines ordered pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 1202.4 (Priority 3).

25 Section 5. DEPOSIT OF MONEYS. All moneys collected shall be deposited in the
26 general fund of the County.
