

HOMELAND MDP LINE 2 STAGE 2



The Homeland MDP Line 2, Stage 2 project involves the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 800 lineal feet of underground storm drain facilities ranging in size from 18—inches to 45—inches. The proposed project is located in the unincorporated area of Homeland, Riverside County. The proposed project will be located in Guthridge Lane and Wakefield Avenue within the existing street right—of—way. The proposed project starts at the existing basin located southwest of the intersection of Guthridge Lane and Wakefield Avenue, travels north in Guthridge Lane for approximately 150 feet, then east in Wakefield Avenue approximately to the intersection of Wakefield Avenue and Ritter Avenue.
