BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The Youth Portal is a highly flexible and customized gated community that is password protected, available 24/7 and accessible via the internet. Members can explore and access career options, internships, employment opportunities, post-secondary education options, relevant news, events, discussions, networking, career mentoring and career assessments.

Monster Evolutions held quarterly meetings throughout the existing contract period to review performance, drive enhancements, and maintain progress. They have provided creative design services to support and enhance the functionality of the site and provide guidance to Economic Development Agency staff.

The Monster Evolutions current proposal offers a reduction in overall costs, providing a significant savings plan in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th (most savings) contract year, while delivering the same level of service. The contract started August 31, 2010, and will end on August 31, 2014. The period of performance is one year with pricing for a four year period based on contract compliance and renewal.

The below information is provided in support of my Department requesting approval for a sole source. Outside of a duly declared emergency, the time to develop a statement of work or specifications is not in itself justification for sole source.

1. Supply/Service being requested:

Youth Internet Portal by Monster Evolutions

2. Supplier being requested:

Monster Worldwide, Inc.

3. Alternative suppliers that can or might be able to provide supply/service:

Employon, AIRS/The Right Thing, Career Builder/Personified

4. Extent of market search conducted:

EDA previously conducted research when it originally (2010) purchased the Monster Evolutions adult and youth portals. Research on the above referenced companies demonstrated that Monster was the only company who could create a portal utilizing EDA's website addresses and had an online career services site ready to deploy with minimal customization required.

5. Unique features of the supply/service being requested from this supplier, which no alternative supplier can provide:

Unlike other competitors, Monster Evolutions can be hosted on the www.myiecareer.com website for access by youth in EDA's year round youth programs. Also, businesses can post job opportunities, internships and volunteer opportunities directly on the site. It is a password-protected online youth community, available 24/7 and accessible via the internet. Members can explore and access career options, internships, employment opportunities, post-secondary education options, relevant news, events, discussions, networking, career mentoring and career assessments.

6. Reasons why my department requires these unique features and what benefit will accrue to the county:

Youth unemployment is more than double that of adults. Performance requirements for Workforce Investment Act Youth funds include entered employment. This portal has expanded the services being offered by the Youth Opportunity Centers and has provided significant resources for youth to engage themselves in the workforce.

7. Price Reasonableness including purchase price and any ongoing maintenance or ancillary costs from the supplier:

M.O. 3.30, dated August 31, 2010 approved a sole source for Youth Internet Portal with Monster Evolutions) for 3 years (year 1 \$98,500, year 2 \$80,000, and year 3 \$83,200) totaling \$263,700. Workforce Development recently negotiated a cost reduction for years 2 and 3 from \$80,000 to \$75,000; year 3 from \$83,000 to \$75,000 for a cost savings of \$13,000. The reduction in cost comes with the addition of a 4th year at \$55,000. The new total for years 2 through 4 is \$205,000. Costs are allowable based on the cost principle guidance contained in the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-87.

8. Does moving forward on this product or service further obligate the county to future similar contractual arrangements or any ongoing costs affiliated with this sole source? (Maintenance, support, or upgrades, if so, please explain).

Yes. Anticipated use of this product will be on-going as long as the Workforce Development Centers provide services to the youth of Riverside County and the funding is available to support the need.

9. Period of Performance:

The period of performance is for the addition of a 4th year ending in 2014 via negotiations for the cost saving of \$13,000 for years 2 and 3.
