BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The Sheriff's Inmate Program Group requires additional space, this project would convert existing warehouse space and convert it into offices.

The Economic Development Agency (EDA) has selected TR Design Group from the pre-qualified list to provide architectural and engineering design services for the Smith Correctional Facility Site B Remodel project.

The bid documents are now complete and EDA requests approval to solicit bids for construction of this project. EDA will return to the Board under separate cover to approve the project budget and execute any related project agreements.

All costs associated with this project will be funded through the Inmate Welfare Fund, thus no net county cost will be incurred.
