BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the rehabilitation of Dillon Road from Avenue 44 to 0.28 miles north of Landfill Road in the City of Indio, City of Coachella and unincorporated area of Riverside County.

The proposed road improvements will consist of grind in place and overlay of existing pavement, cold plane and overlay, and reconstruction of the intersection at Avenue 44. Additional improvements include replacement of existing asphalt concrete dikes and overside drains, shoulder backing, and placement of thermoplastic pavement markings and striping.

The City of Indio and the City of Coachella will reimburse the County for the improvements being done within their respective jurisdictions. The cooperative agreement between the Cities and the County will be submitted to the Board for approval prior to the award of this project.
