BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541 and 725 authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Multiple Notices of Violation and Administrative Citations were issued. Subsequently, on or about February 17, 2005, Case No. CV02-1336 was closed and reopened under Case No. CV05-0723 in order to continue to address the outstanding violation(s). On or about September 19, 2008, the property owner brought the property into compliance.

The Riverside County Code Enforcement Department seeks to recover its costs associated with the handling of Case Nos. CV02-3407 and CV05-0723.
