BACKGROUND (continued):

On December 20, 2011, Agenda Item 3.28, the Board approved the Tentative Agreement between the Riverside County Deputy District Attorneys Association (RCDDAA) and the County of Riverside effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015. As part of the Agreement, it was agreed to provide current and future employees in the RCDDAA monthly contributions in the amount of \$256 per month toward County-sponsored retiree health plans.

RCDDAA retirees participate in California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) health plans. Currently, there are 19 RCDDAA retirees enrolled. Resolution No. 2012-037 (Attachment A), contains direction acceptable to CalPERS and will become effective April 1, 2012, upon your approval.

RESOLUTION FIXING THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT

WHEREAS (1)	Government Code Section 22892(a) provides that a local agency contracting under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act shall fix the amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the amount required under Section 22892(b)(1) of the Act, and
WHEREAS, (2)	the County of Riverside, hereinafter referred to as Public Agency is local agency contracting under the Act for participation by members of the Riverside County Deputy District Attorneys Association (RCDDAA) Unit now, therefore be it
RESOLVED, (a)	That the employer's contribution for each employee or annuitant shall be the amount necessary to pay the full cost of his/her enrollment, including the enrollment of his/her family members in a health benefit plan up to a maximum of \$256 per month, plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund Assessments; and be it further
RESOLVED, (b)	That the County of Riverside has fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507 in electing the benefits set forth above.
RESOLVED, (c)	That the coverage under the Act be effective April 1, 2012.
