BACKGROUND: On January 6, 2012, the Menifee City Manager approved the city's second amendment to the law enforcement services agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service by deleting two daily Patrol Deputy Sheriff positions and adding two Community Services Officer (CSO) II positions. The CSO II positions will assist sworn Patrol officers in providing traffic enforcement. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

This personnel action will result in the deletion of the following Position Control Numbers for the Deputy Sheriff positions: 33754 and 96600.

Based on the January 13, 2012 date for the service reduction, and a projected start date of May 3rd for the 2 CSO II positions, staff estimates an overall decrease in Contract City law enforcement revenue of \$179,000.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW
ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF
RIVERSIDE AND CITY OF MENIFEE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of its Sheriff's Department, and the City of Menifee, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 21, 2009, for services effective July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2012, as amended on September 28, 2010, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

110 supported hours per day. (Approximate equivalent of twenty-three (23) Deputy Sheriff positions @ 1,780 annual productive hours per position)

One (1) Deputy Sheriff (unsupported) position – Task Force

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Quail Valley Patrol

One (1) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) position – Motor Officer

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Traffic Team

Four (4) Community Service Officer II positions

One (1) Community Service Officer I position
