RE: Skyview Road Reconstruction Project in the City of Jurupa Valley.

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BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the reconstruction of a portion of Skyview Road that is now in the City of Jurupa Valley, Riverside County.

Skyview Road has been renamed and was the original Limonite Avenue. This road was constructed many years ago and portions of the road have subsided over time. The subsided areas have created dips and irregularities in the pavement surface. This project proposes to reconstruct 550 feet of pavement and resurface an additional 915 feet of pavement along Skyview Road at and near Peralta Place.

The County identified the need for pavement rehabilitation on Skyview Road, funds were budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. The Transportation Department is recommending that we complete delivery of this project.

The bid documents include the following schedules of work:

Base Bid:

Primary items of work on Skyview Road

Alternate 1:

Utility repair and adjustment work funded by the Rubidoux Community

Services District (RCSD).

Alternate 1 is intended to be awarded with the base bid contract. If utility repair and adjustment is required, the work can be done either by the RCSD or the Contractor. If the work is done by the Contractor, RCSD will be invoiced for completed work per Alternate 1.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
