- Successful completion of one (1)-proctored moderate sedation case under the direct supervision of a RCRMC practitioner holding this privilege.

<u>Required Previous Experience</u>: Knowledge of airway management and ACLS/PALS certification. <u>Maintenance of Privilege:</u> Demonstrated current competence and evidence of the performance of at least four (4) moderate sedation cases in the past 24 months based on results of ongoing professional practice evaluation and outcomes.
