BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541 and 725 authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Regarding Case No. CV03-1865 (accumulated rubbish / substandard structure) Notices of Violation and Administrative Citations were issued. On or about June 9, 2004, the property owner voluntarily removed the violations. Additionally, regarding Case No. CV10-06539 (accumulated rubbish) a Notice of Violation and Order to Remove Accumulated Rubbish was issued on September 13, 2010. On or about September 8, 2011, the accumulated rubbish was abated from the subject property under the direction of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 2008.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Abatement Costs has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
