SUBJECT: FY12 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Adopt Resolution # 2012-117 that identifies the local Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Signature Authority; and,
- 2) Authorize the Riverside County Fire Department – Office of Emergency Services (OES) to apply to the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) for \$574,146 in formula-based funding under EMPG on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area (OA).

BACKGROUND: The purpose of the EMPG is to support comprehensive emergency management at the state, tribal and local levels and to encourage the improvement of mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities for all hazards. Eligible grant recipients are California's 58 Operational Areas.

BACKGROUND (Continued):

As defined in Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 (as amended through 533.5), "Operational Area means an intermediate level of the state emergency services organization, consisting of a county and all political subdivisions within the county area." OES applies for EMPG funding on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area. EMPG funds are awarded to eligible agencies throughout the OA through an application that represents the consensus of the Riverside County Operational Area Planning Committee (OAPC). The OAPC consists of Riverside County agencies and jurisdictions.

A new Signature Authority Resolution is required with each year's application.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

Federally funded and dollar-for-dollar local cash or in-kind match. Each agency that is awarded funding is responsible for providing the dollar-for-dollar cash or in-kind match requirement.
