

RE: Camino Real Resurfacing Project in the City of Jurupa Valley.

April 19, 2012

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BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the resurfacing of Camino Real from Limonite Avenue to 263' north of Blackhills Drive in the City of Jurupa Valley. The County identified the need for pavement resurfacing on Camino Real, funds were budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. The City considers resurfacing of Camino Real as a priority and desires County to continue as lead agency.

During preparation of plans, the City requested the following two segments of Camino Real be added to the project.

1. Camino Real: Linares Avenue to Limonite Avenue
2. Camino Real: Red Mountain Drive to 250' north of Whitney Drive

The City's engineer has approved the plans.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed road improvements will consist of grinding the existing pavement in place, removing or cold plane pavement, re-grading the surface, and placing of new AC pavement.

A cooperative agreement will be drafted to define terms of cost sharing for these improvements. The agreement will be presented to this Board for approval prior to or concurrent with award of a construction contract. In general, County staff has reached an understanding with City staff by which the City's contribution would be 50% of the total project costs to a capped amount, with the City's contribution to be paid back over time.

Bid documents include the following schedules of work:

Base Bid: Primary items of work on Camino Real.

Alternate Bid: Camino Real, adjustment of manholes, to be funded by Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) under the terms of a cooperative agreement, which will be executed prior or concurrently with to the submission of the construction contract for award.

If the utility owner concur with bid prices, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the alternate bid schedule will be included with the contract award and the costs for the work will be funded by that utility owner.

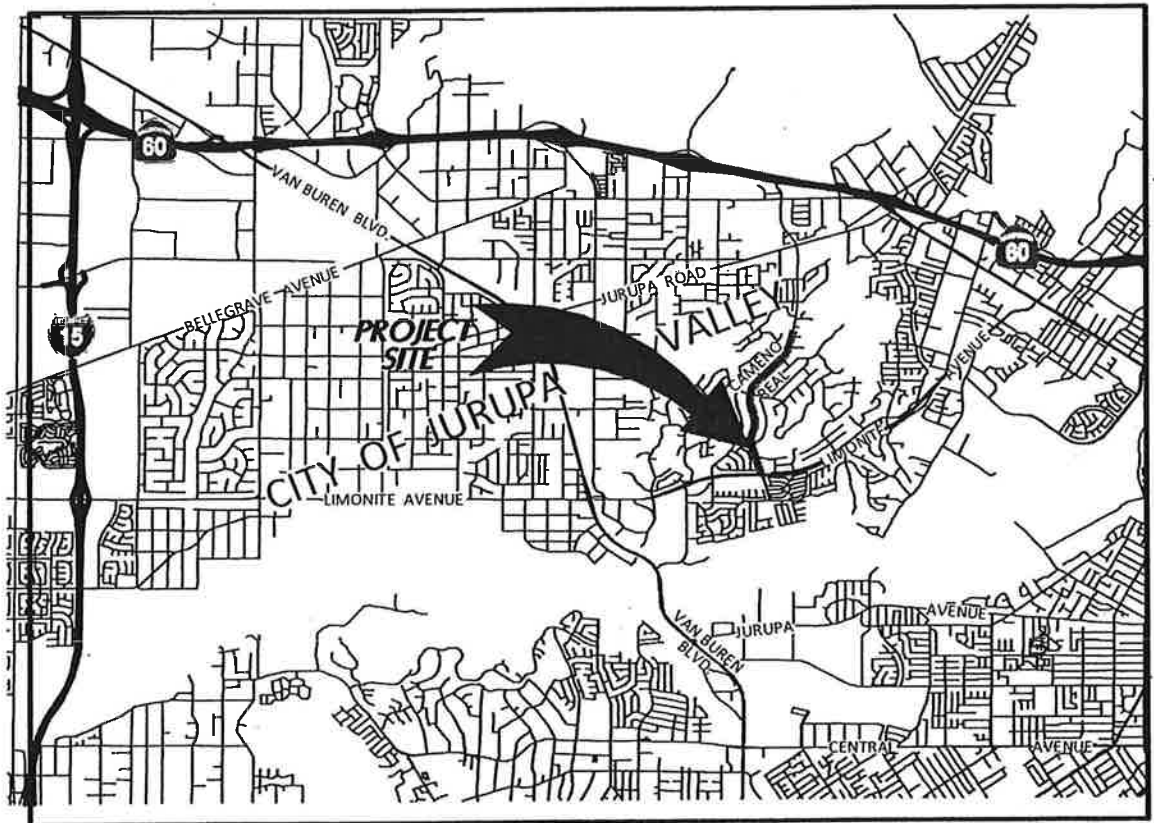
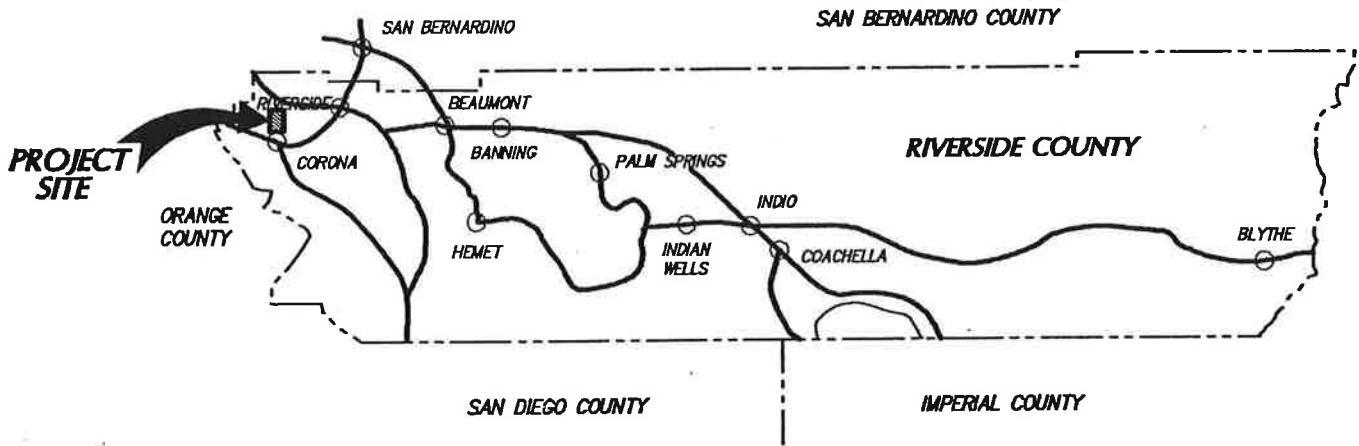
The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
