RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:


- 1) assess the reasonable costs of abatement of a public nuisance [construction without permits (detached garage/room addition/storage shed) and unpermitted land use (shipping containers) in the above-referenced matter to be **six thousand, nine hundred nineteen dollars (US \$6,919.00)**;
- (2) assess the costs of abatement against the above-described subject property;
- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien;
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment; and
- (5) authorize and direct the Code Enforcement Department to take any reasonable actions to collect the amount owed.

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BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457, 348 and 725 authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Multiple Notices of Hearing and Administrative Citations were issued. Subsequently, on or about November 10, 2011, the case was closed with the violations remaining. Accordingly, the County of Riverside Department of Code Enforcement seeks to recover its costs associated with the handling of this matter to date, but does not waive its right to recover costs for future enforcement actions.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Abatement Costs has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
