



**BACKGROUND:** The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Murrieta Hot Springs Road and Willows Avenue, in the Temecula area. The proposed traffic signal will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements and pedestrian crossings. Additionally, the storm drain inlets and median nose are being modified to provide a clear path for the proposed marked crosswalk. New ADA compliant ramps will be installed at all four curb returns of the proposed traffic signal. This project will also provide striping and signing improvements at the intersection.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.
