SUBJECT: Acceptance of the Grant Award from the California Department of Food and Agriculture to the Riverside County Department of Animal Services for spay or neuter services and programs.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1) Accept the Grant Award from the California Department of Food and Agriculture ("CDFA") for the Riverside County Department of Animal Services ("RCDAS") for spay or neuter services and programs, in the amount of \$22,500, until all funds are used; and

2) Authorize the Director of Animal Services, or his designee, to administer all actions necessary and sign all documents related to the administration of this Grant Award on behalf of the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND: The CDFA awarded RCDAS \$22,500 based on the funding formula provided in the California Revenue Taxation Code (CRTC) Section 18755.2(c) for the Municipal Spay/Neuter Grant Program. All funds received must be used to supplement, not replace, other funding sources for spay/neuter services and programs. Additionally, no grant funds shall be used to spay or neuter any animal that is impounded by an eligible municipal shelter.
