**SUBJECT:** University of The Pacific Pharmacy Grant

**BACKGROUND:**

University of the Pacific's Thomas J. Long School of Pharmacy and Health Sciences an evergreen affiliation agreement with Riverside County Regional Medical Center to mutually provide educational experiences and programs for students duly enrolled at the University and the professional staff of RCRMC.

The University will provide funding in the amount of \$15,000 annually to RCRMC to support the professional development activities for the pharmacy personnel who participate in the provision of advanced pharmacy practice experiences at RCRMC for 12 to 15 students per year. This agreement shall be effective August 1, 2011 for three years, and as long as RCRMC remains the host site for the Inland Empire Region of the University. The agreement will be renewed at that time after review by both parties.
