BACKGROUND: The State Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) has allocated funding to the County under the Federal Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) 2012/2013 Program. The purpose of this funding is to promote development or continuation of local juvenile justice programs that hold juvenile offenders accountable to the community and courts. The allocation to Riverside County for expenditures during Fiscal Year 2012-2013 is \$137,528, and with a 10% local match (\$15,281), the total project cost is \$152,809.

In Fiscal Year 2012-2013, JABG funding of \$117,683 will be used to support the collection of data for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force by reimbursing the salary and benefits of a Deputy Sheriff and an Office Assistant II from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

The balance of the JABG funding, \$19,845, will be made available for reimbursement to the host city for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force for expenditures on behalf of the Gang Task Force for services and supplies. The City of La Quinta is serving as the host city for FY 2012-2013 and will fund their share of the match. The Sheriff's Department will prepare a funding agreement between the city and county. The Department anticipated \$81,656 in grant revenue in preparing the FY 12/13 budget, therefore additional adjustments are necessary in the amount of \$55,872.

The allocation of project funding to the two agencies will be as follows:
