BACKGROUND:

CAP Riverside has operated the Cool Center Program since 2001 as part of its Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan. The Plan is a comprehensive response to the impact of extreme hot weather on low-income county residents, especially targeting vulnerable seniors, disabled individuals, and small children, with emphasis in the desert areas (eastern Riverside County) where temperatures often exceed 105 degrees from May through October.

The Rummond Senior Center is the only accessible facility in the Thermal area that can accommodate elderly residents and others who do not have transportation to travel to a cooling site located further away. To keep the facility open for extended hours, a paid employee must remain on site from 1:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

On October 2, 2007 (#3.47), the Board approved the agreement between Regional Access Project Foundation and CAP Riverside in the amount of \$25,000 for the term July 1, 2007 through October 31, 2007. On July 29, 2008 (#3.106), the Board approved Amendment #1 to the agreement in the amount of \$7,000 for the term July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. On July 21, 2009 (#3.8), the Board approved Amendment #2 to the agreement in the amount of \$9,300 for the term June 15, 2009 through October 31, 2009. On June 29, 2010 (#3.19), the Board approved Amendment #3 to the agreement in the amount of \$9,300 for the term June 1, 2010 through October 31, 2010. On June 14, 2011 (#3.11), the Board approved Amendment #4 to the agreement in the amount of \$9,300, for the term June 1, 2011 through October 15, 2011.

Amendment #5 provides \$9,300 to support staffing to keep the center open for extended hours, and to provide nutritional snacks and water for the term June 15, 2012 through October 15, 2012.

THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT BETWEEN the REGIONAL ACCESS PROJECT Foundation, hereinafter referred to as FOUNDATION, and COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY, hereinafter referred to as PROVIDER, in order to provide six year funding, is amended as follows:

- 1. Section 1. DEFINITIONS line (d) is amended to read: "Fiscal Year One (1)" shall be from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008; "Fiscal Year Two (2)" shall be from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009; "Fiscal Year Three (3)" shall be from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, "Fiscal Year Four (4)" shall be from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; "Fiscal Year Five (5)" shall be from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 and "Fiscal Year Six (6) shall be from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.
- 2. <u>Section 3. PAYMENTS is amended to read</u>: The total payment due under this agreement shall not exceed Nine Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$9,300.00) for sixth year. One Payment for full amount shall be made to PROVIDER.
- 3. <u>Section 4. TERM is amended to read</u>: The term of this agreement for sixth year funding shall run from June 15, 2012 to October 15, 2012, unless otherwise terminated as herein provided.
- 4. <u>Section 8. REPORTS is amended to read</u>: PROVIDER at such times and in such forms as FOUNDATION may require, shall furnish to FOUNDATION such statements, records, reports, data and information as FOUNDATION may request pertaining to PROVIDER'S performance of services and the use of funds hereunder. PROVIDER shall submit a single report indicating number of persons
