BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Specific improvements will include applying asphalt rejuvenating seal to the runway and taxiway areas, and reapplying airfield markings to keep current within the general aviation facilities guidelines. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will review and approve the contract documents. The project will be funded with FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grants and Aviation Division Capital Improvement Funds. There will be no impact upon the County's General Fund.
