**SUBJECT:** Elsinore Peak Radio and Microwave Communications Building – Asset Removal

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the discharge of accountability pursuant to Government Code 24051 for demolished Facilities Management Asset Number 315, Building Number LE515.

**BACKGROUND:** The Radio and Microwave Communications Building (LE515), located at 35607 Forestry Road at Elsinore Peak has been replaced by a new building also located at 35607 Forestry Road. The older radio and microwave communications building has been demolished in order to provide space to install a backup generator and above ground fuel tank. The generator and fuel tank were required to support the recently completed Elsinore Peak Public Safety Enterprise Communications facility. The approval of this board action will allow EDA/Facilities Management to retire the asset for the older radio facility.
