BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated April 10, 2012 (agenda item 3.51), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Mecca Roundabout Street Improvements at the intersection of 4th Street and Hammond Road, in the unincorporated community of Mecca.

During the advertisement period, three addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans, specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and to take into account addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1, Addendum No. 2, and Addendum No.3.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, May 23, 2012. Five bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid of base bid schedules A, B & C. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Mamco, Inc. in the amount of \$1,818,018 which is \$129,072 (6.63%) less than the Engineer's Estimate. The Agreement includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule A (Project B9-0997): Roundabout street construction.

Base Bid Schedule B (Project B9-0997): Roundabout landscape construction - Phase 1 of 2.

Base Bid Schedule C (Project X1005): Block wall, sign replacement and ADA parking spaces associated with the Mecca Streets Revitalization Phase 2 project.

Alternate Bid Schedule 1 (Project B9-0997): Roundabout landscape construction - Phase 2 of 2. **Not selected for award.** The Phase 2 of 2 landscaping will be deferred until the voters annex into a Landscape Maintenance District.

Alternate Bid Schedule 2 (Project X1005): Monitoring well abandonment. **Not selected for award.** This work is being performed by a separate contract.

A letter of protest was submitted by the second low bidder on the project, objecting to a matter of form in submittal of the UDBE forms and the failure to fill in a proposal form cost line in words although the numbers were filled in and legible. Transportation and County Counsel reviewed the protest and determined that the bid submittal was in accord with the bid requirements, or at the most was a minor irregularity that could be waived, and the bid protestor was so notified. There has been no further communication regarding the protest.

As a continuation of the street improvements in the downtown Mecca area, the proposed Mecca Roundabout Street Improvement Project will include the reconfiguration of the intersection of 4th Street and Hammond Road from an offset intersection to a roundabout.

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The project will benefit the community by improving traffic circulation, pedestrian access, and street drainage and by eliminating blight. The improvements will include the reconstruction of the existing pavement and the addition of sidewalk, curb, gutter, perimeter walls, landscaping, decorative stamped concrete, decorative decomposed granite and intersection safety lighting.

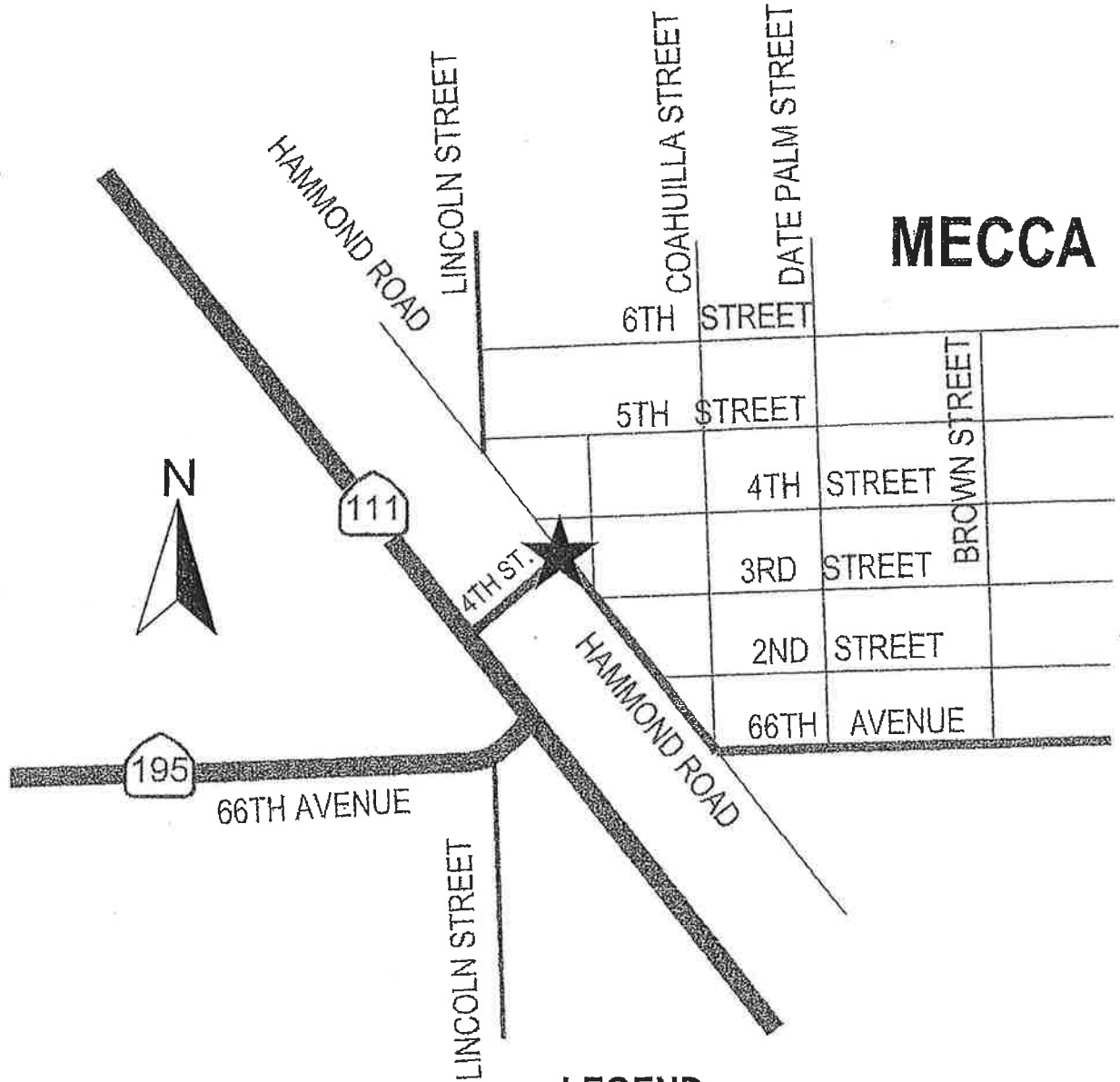
The proposed construction will be funded by a combination of Federal Highway Administration Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Funds (CMAQ Funds), and Redevelopment Agency (RDA) Funds. RDA funding will be under the terms of funding agreements that were approved by the Board on June 28, 2011 (Item #3.64) and August 31, 2010 (Item 3.50).

The Contractor has executed the contract and has provided bonds and insurance, which meet the requirements of the contract. The contractor is qualified.
