BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated June 5, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.63) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Brown Street drainage and street improvements from Souder Street to Cajalco Road, in the Mead Valley area.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Tuesday, July 3, 2012. Nine bids were received, ranging from \$177,466 to \$261,105. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Panorama General Engineering, Inc. of Rancho Cucamonga, CA in the amount of \$177,466, which is \$59,614 (25.2%) below the Engineer's Estimate. The project is expected to be finished within the existing budget as shown on Attachment 'A'.

Project funding is being provided through an agreement between the County and the Redevelopment Agency approved on June 28, 2011 under Agenda Items 3.119 and 4.18.

The low water crossing is located approximately 250 feet south of the intersection of Cajalco Road and Brown Street where Cajalco Creek flows from east to west over the existing asphalt surface. This project will replace the existing Brown Street low water crossing by raising the profile of Brown Street to accommodate the installation of multiple barrel corrugated metal pipe culverts.

The proposed drainage improvements will improve safety by conveying flows under Brown Street and reducing the need for road closures during rain events.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid.

The Contractor has executed the contract and has provided performance and payment bonds, which meet the requirements of the contract.



Item 2: Clarification of Road Closure for Brown Street and Detour Plan. Refer to section "TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM" on pages 51 through 53, and "LIQUIDATED DAMAGES" on page 50.

Full closure of Brown Street between the project limits will be allowed for a period of <u>30 consecutive Calendar Days</u> within the <u>40 Working Days</u> established for project completion.

Detour Plan for Brown Street. The following special provision for "Detour Plan" is added and made part here of:

DETOUR PLAN:

The awarded Contractor shall provide detour plans in accordance with the "Traffic Control System" and "Maintaining Traffic" specifications. The plan shall provide necessary information regarding the required signs and their locations. The work included in this item shall include supplying all labor, materials, equipment, supervision, and incidentals required to implement, monitor, and maintain the detour route(s) as shown on the Detour Plan.

The Contractor's responsibility shall include, but not limited to, traffic signs, special signs, portable changeable message signs, barricades, type III barricades, changing internally illuminated street name panel, changing street name sign plates, delineators, and other incidental items for the detour.

The Contractor shall be responsible for implementing, monitoring, and maintaining the detour route(s) until the acceptance of the project.

Forty-eight hours prior to implementing the detour, the Contractor shall be responsible for contacting the County Traffic Signal Maintenance Division at (951) 955-6894. Contractor shall coordinate all modifications to adjacent signals with the Signal Maintenance Division. Contact person within the Signal Maintenance Division—is Delaney Davezan.

Full compensation for the Detour Plan shall include all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in furnishing, placing, operating, maintaining, repairing, and transporting items as directed by the Engineer and shall be considered as included in the Lump Sum price paid for Traffic Control System and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 3: Portable Changeable Message Signs

The following special provision for "Portable Changeable Message Signs" is added and made part here of:

PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS:

A minimum of three (3) portable changeable message signs shall be furnished, placed, operated, and maintained at locations shown on the plans or where designated by the Engineer and shall conform to the provisions in Section 12, "Construction Area Traffic Control Devices" of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions. Messages displayed on the portable changeable message signs shall be provided to the contractor by the Engineer at the preconstruction meeting and shall conform to Section

12-3.12 "Portable Changeable Message Signs" of the Standard Specifications and "Maintaining Traffic" of these special provisions.

A portable changeable message sign shall be placed in advance of the first warning sign for each stationary lane closure. Additionally, portable changeable message signs shall be placed before road closures.

Full compensation for portable changeable message signs shall include all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in furnishing, placing, operating, maintaining, repairing, transporting from location to location and removing portable changeable message signs as directed by the Engineer, and shall be considered as included in the lump sum price paid for Traffic Control System and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 4: Clarification of Dust Control Sign. Refer to GENERAL CONDITIONS, Section 23, "DUST ABATEMENT" on pages 18 through 21, and AQMD RECOMMENDATIONS on pages 22 through 47.

The Contractor shall furnish and post one dust mitigation sign, which shall be, at a minimum, in accordance with the AQMD Recommendations.

Item 5: Clarification of Roadside Signs. Refer to section "ROADSIDE SIGN" on page 80.

County Standards No. 1221 and 1222 mentioned on the second paragraph are provided and attached herewith as **Attachment "A"** for reference.

Item 6: Revision Replace Traffic Bearing Pull Box. Refer to section "REPLACE TRAFFIC BEARING PULL BOX" on page 84. The last paragraph is deleted and replaced with the following:

"Full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools and equipment and for doing all the work involved in replacing existing pull boxes with traffic bearing pull boxes, including new conduit extensions, loop stub-out, sweeps, and adjustment of existing conduit to accommodate new pull boxes to new grade, as shown on the plans and specified in these Special Provisions shall be considered as included in the contract unit bid price paid per each for Replace Pull Box [Traffic Bearing] and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor."




DIRT LOCATION

SIDEWALK LOCATION










