**BACKGROUND:** On July 11, 2012, the Mayor of Eastvale approved the city's first Amendment to its five-year law enforcement services Agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of a fully supported Deputy Sheriff position to the city's traffic enforcement detail. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Based on the October 1, 2012 scheduled date for the service addition, staff estimates an overall increase in Contract City law enforcement revenue of \$190,000. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved contract rates.
