#### **BACKGROUND:**

On January 10, 2012, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2012-001 which designated the Housing Authority of the County of Riverside as the successor agency for the housing functions previously performed by the former Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside. Pursuant to AB1484, a new Low Moderate Income Housing Asset Fund was established to accept the transfer of the balance of Successor Agency Low Moderate Income Housing Set Aside Funds to be managed by the Housing Authority. This Low Moderate Income Housing Fund Asset Fund will have its own Expense and Revenue appropriations pursuant to the attached Schedule A.
