
Each of these representatives keep themselves abreast of actions concerning the Strategic Plan and District communications and follow up by giving a report at each Commission meeting.


Each of these representatives keeps abreast of actions concerning the Strategic Plan and District communications, and follows up by giving a report at each Commission meeting.

Overall Commission Activities

The Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Commission assisted the Park District and local communities by educating the public on illegal off-highway vehicle use and providing information on legal venues where off-highway use can be found. Commissioners visited Wildomar OHV Park and Ocotillo Wells State Vehicular Recreational Area and made recommendations on possible OHVR sites within Riverside County. The Commission has completed a Draft Business Plan. In addition, they supported an OHV grant received by the Park District for restoration to an area located off Gilman Springs Road in the Badlands that has been abused by illegal off-road use.

The Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Commission will continue in its purpose to advise and make recommendations concerning the planning, acquisition, development and use of OHVR parks within the District.
